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LIFE GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Read Hebrews 11:1. The writer uses two words to describe faith: “sure” and “certain.” Do those words describe the level and characteristic of your faith? Why, or why not? How can those words more adequately describe the quality of your faith?

2. Was there a time in your life when your faith was stronger than it is now? What do you think contributed to your faith’s strength at that time? What is contributing to your faith not being as strong now? How will you grow a stronger faith in the days to come?

3. What do you think is the connection between the level of your faith and the level of your obedience? Do you believe enough in God’s character to take his promises at his word? Do you have enough faith in God’s promises to obey his commands? Where and how can you improve in this area?

4. Think back over your walk with Christ. When were the times when God seemed to really honor your faith? When were the times your faith seemed to really make a difference? How does that help you and inspire you now? How can God’s faithfulness to honor your faith in the past make a difference now?

5. Dave gave several practical suggestions to grow and increase your faith. Which ones make the most sense to you? Which ones can you begin to put into practice right now? Do you need someone to hold you accountable for them? Who will that be? When will you ask them?

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
